- (1) Audit and Finance Committee is required to meet at least four times a year. The Committee shall consist of not less than 3 members. Quorum is one-third of its members but not less than 2.
- (2) Compensation Committee meets at least three times per year as circumstances require. The Committee shall consist of not less than 2 members. Quorum is one-third of its members, but not less than 2.
- (3) Safety and Operations Committee meets at least quarterly as circumstances require. Committee size: not less than 2 members. Quorum is one-third of its members, but not less than 2.
- (4) Nominating and Governance Committee meets at least three times a year as circumstances require, including in advance of the Annual Meetings of Shareholders. The Committee shall consist of not less than 2 members. Quorum is one-third of its members, but not less than 2.
- (5) Pricing Committee meets as needed. The Committee shall consist of not less than two members (Audit and Finance Committee Chair serves as alternate). Quorum is a majority of its 2 members.
