SUBJECT: Informational Advice Letter
1999 Second Quarter Report of Southern California Edison
Company for Competitive Local Exchange Projects

PURPOSE

In compliance with Decision No. 98-12-083 (D.98-12-083), dated December 17, 1998, Southern California Edison Company (SCE) hereby transmits for filing the attached 1999 quarterly report that summarizes the construction projects for competitive local exchange that are anticipated for the second quarter of 1999.

BACKGROUND

In D.98-12-083, Appendix C to Appendix D, the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) outlined its Mitigation Monitoring Plan, describing the mitigation monitoring process for the Competitive Local Carriers' (CLCs) proposed projects and describing the roles and responsibilities of government agencies in implementing and enforcing the selected mitigation measures.

The Mitigation Monitoring Program requires the CLCs to implement Mitigation Measure B of Appendix D to D.98-12-083, by filing a quarterly report as an informational advice letter, one month prior to the beginning of each quarter, that summarizes the construction projects that they intend to construct in the coming quarter. The report will contain a description of the project and its location and a summary of the CLC's compliance with the Mitigation Measures described in the Negative Declaration. The purpose of the report is to inform the local agencies of future projects so that coordination of projects among CLCs in the same locality can be conducted.

The quarterly report will be filed with the appropriate planning agency of the locality where the project(s) will occur and as an informational advice letter with the Commission's Telecommunications Division. This informational advice letter fulfills the latter requirement.

No cost information is required for this advice filing.

This advice filing will not increase any rate or charge, cause withdrawal of service, or conflict with any other schedule or rule.

EFFECTIVE DATE

It is requested that this advice filing become effective on the 40th calendar day after the dated filed, April 10, 1999. No resolution is required for approval of this advice filing.

NOTICE

Anyone wishing to protest this advice filing may do so by sending a letter no later than 20 days after the date of this advice filing. Protests should be mailed to:

There are no restrictions on who may file a protest, but the protest shall set forth specifically the grounds upon which it is based and shall be submitted expeditiously.
