SANTA CATALINA ISLAND
DOMESTIC SERVICE - MULTIFAMILY ACCOMMODATION

Sheet 1 (T)

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to domestic service of liquified petroleum gas-air to a multifamily accommodation on a single premises where all of the single-family accommodations are not separately submetered. This schedule is closed to new installations.

TERRITORY

The City of Avalon, and vicinity, Santa Catalina Island.

RATES

The rate of the single-family domestic rate, Schedule G-1, shall be adjusted as follows: (T)

Energy Charge:

The baseline quantity of gas to be billed under rates designated as applicable to Baseline Service shall be any applicable daily Medical Baseline Allocation permitted under Part E., Paragraph 4, of the Preliminary Statement, plus the applicable daily seasonal Baseline Allocation determined by multiplying the appropriate number of single-family dwellings times the therms per day per single-family dwelling set forth below:

<u>Season</u>	<u>Time Period</u>	<u>Therms Per Day Per Single-Family Dwelling</u>
Winter	November 1, through April 30	1.348
Summer	May 1 through October 31	0.526

Minimum Charge:

The Minimum Charge shall be the same as set forth in Special Condition 1, Minimum Customer Charge of Schedule G-1. (T)

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. Seasonal Service: For summer cottage customers and others who normally require service for only part of the year, this schedule is applicable only on an annual contract.
2. Baseline Quantity Notification: It is the responsibility of the customer to advise SCE within 15 days following any change in the number of single-family accommodations or residential units qualifying for baseline allocations, and any change in qualifications for medical baseline allocations. (T)
3. Miscellaneous Loads: Miscellaneous gas loads such as gas laundry room equipment, and other similar gas load incidental to the operation of the premises as a multifamily accommodation served on the same meter will be considered as domestic usage. Where such service is separately metered, it will be served on a general service rate schedule.
4. Separate Meters Required; Pursuant to Decision No. 88651, April 4, 1978, separate metering by SCE is required for each residential single-family dwelling in a multifamily accommodation where tenants in each occupancy use gas directly in gas appliances which require venting. (T)
5. Nondomestic Enterprises: Gas energy used for nondomestic enterprises such as offices, stores, shops, recreational vehicle parks, campgrounds, restaurants, and other similar establishments will be separately metered and billed under an applicable rate schedule.
